HRSA Tidbits

National Health Service Corps (NHSC) 2023 Class

The National Health Service Corps (NHSC) 2023 class of Scholars and Student-to-Service (S2S) participants are beginning their service site search. NHSC scholars and S2S clinicians are required to serve at an NHSC site between two to four years.

FQHCs are encouraged to update their site profiles and post vacancies to recruit NHSC's top scholars and S2S clinicians. You can create profiles on the [Health Workforce Connector](#) so NHSC sites can search for them.

Below are the HPSA requirements for Class Year 2023. NHSC Scholars and S2S participants are required to serve at NHSC-approved sites that meet the HPSA score requirement below for their discipline.
