- Encourage clients to print and bring FFM Approval Letter to appointments
- Seek client first in MMIS
- If client does not yet appear, please accept copy of FFM letter + ID
- Wait to bill MAP until client shows in MMIS
- Submit bill with copy of letter, copy of client ID
