Senate Bill (SB) 558 Implementation Update

What is SB 558?

- New law, effective Jan. 1, 2018
- Opens up the Oregon Health Plan (OHP) to include more children and teens younger than 19, **regardless of immigration status***
- An estimated **15,000** immigrant youth in Oregon impacted

*All other OHP eligibility criteria for those younger than 19 remain the same
