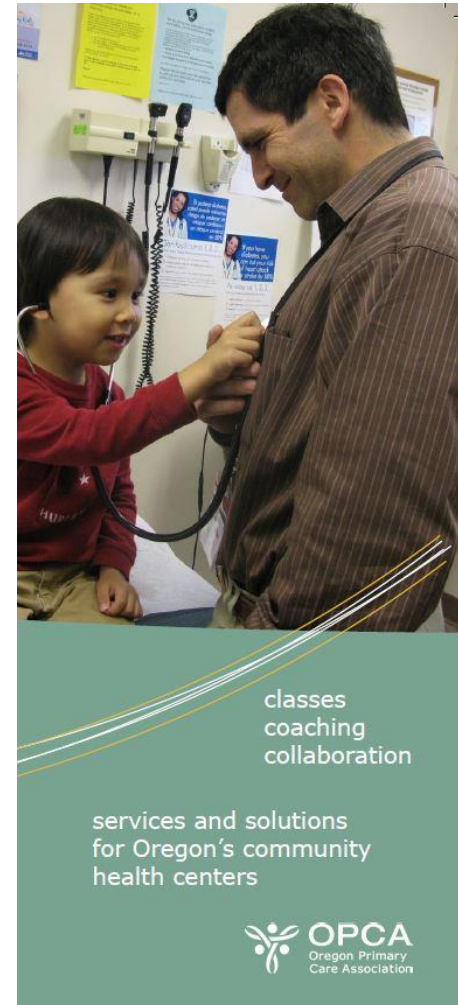


What is the Oregon Primary Care Association (OPCA)?

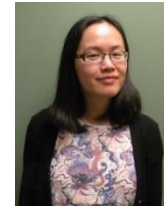
