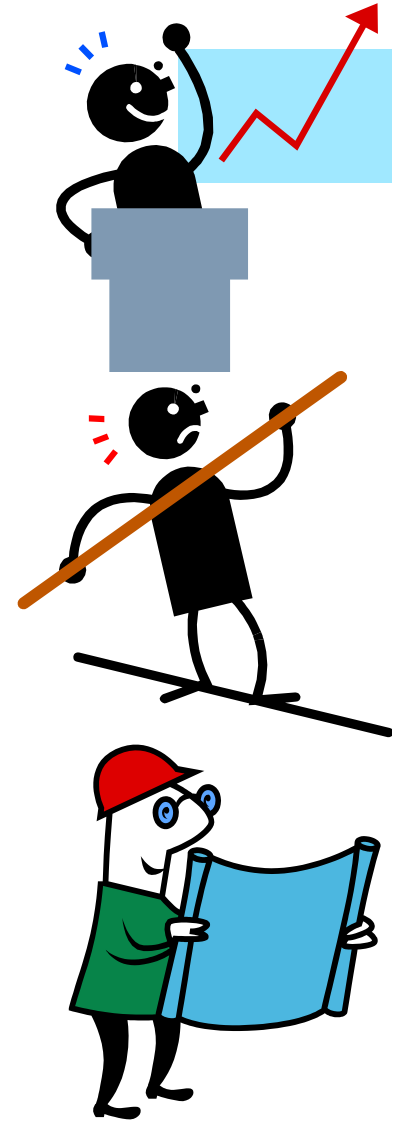

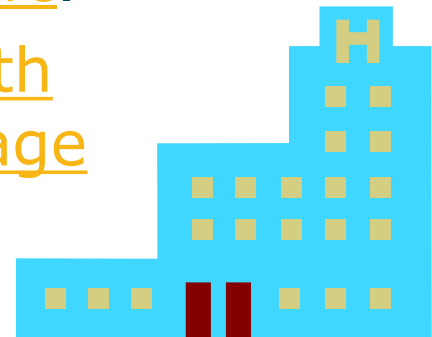


# Hospital Presumptive Eligibility

- What is Hospital Presumptive Eligibility?
  - HPE is an immediate and temporary health care coverage for individuals who are most likely eligible for Medicaid Coverage but have not yet enrolled.
  - HPE is determined by participating hospitals around Oregon.
  - Services accessed with HPE coverage are reimbursed as services covered under OHP.

# HPE continues

- What can OEWs do?
  - OEWs can connect their clients HPE to a participating hospital while they wait for an eligibility determination from Cover Oregon or OHA.
  - OEWs can connect with participating neighbor hospitals to inform them that you are available to in the enrollment to for long term health coverage
