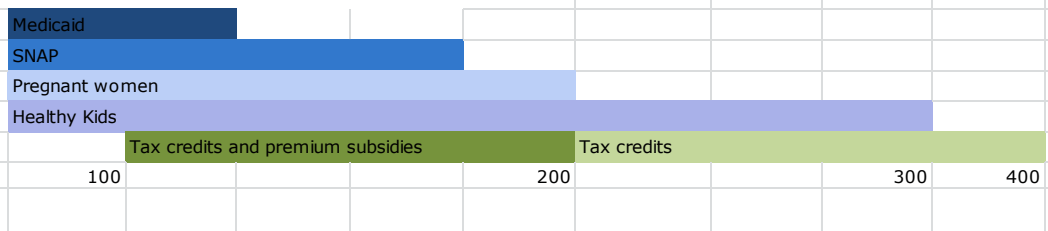

# Current Application Process

Currently Eligible- Health Kids and Pregnant Women. Coverage begins with application- date stamp/Organizational ID#'s matter

Future Medicaid Eligible – Coverage will not begin until 1/1/2014. Applications will be accepted on an ongoing basis- no open enrollment period/restrictions.

Will coverage begin with the date of application once we are in 2014?

# Current Application Process

- Future Exchange Eligible – Coverage will begin on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month after the application is received until the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month.
- Open Enrollment for the Exchange will last through March of this year and then will take place annually October-December of each year after. October-December of 2014 will be the next open enrollment period for coverage that will begin in 2015.

- Fast track(or consent) letter;
  - what the newly 'consented' enrollees should anticipate over the next few weeks and follow up / prompt letter for the fast track enrollees who have not yet replied

- Medicaid & Medicare Dual Eligible
  - Patients can still be dual eligible under the ACA
  - The state of Oregon is still trying to determine if In some cases, Medicare eligible patients may qualify for subsidies and tax credits

## □ Common Strategies:

- Create strong collaborative work with community stakeholders to develop community trust
- Provide one central point of location for inquiries about enrollment
- Flexible work plans to transition to paper applications
- Comprehensive tracking process

## □ Common Barriers

- Unexpected delay of the portal opening
- Hiring and training of O&E workers
- Misinformation and community distrust of the ACA reform
