- ❖ **Technology-Enabled Collaborative Learning Program**  
The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) released a new Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) to evaluate, develop, and expand the use of technology-enabled collaborative learning and capacity building models for health care providers and other professionals to improve retention of health care providers and increase access to health care services. HRSA will award approximately **\$3,800,000 to up to 8 new cooperative agreements over a period of five years**. - ❖ **FY 2024 Primary Care Association Cooperative Agreements Awarded**  
HRSA awarded approximately \$70 million for fiscal year (FY) 2024 Primary Care Association (PCA) Cooperative Agreements funding (HRSA-24-080). This funding will support 52 PCAs in providing training and TA to existing and potential Health Center Program award recipients and look-alikes. This training and TA will support health centers in improving the health of individuals and communities by:

- Increasing access to comprehensive, culturally competent, high-quality primary health care services, including improving safety for people who have experienced or are at risk for intimate partner violence;
- Recruiting and retaining a diverse health care workforce;
- Preparing for, responding to, and recovering from emergent health events;
- Implementing value-based care delivery and ensuring financial sustainability; and
- Accelerating data-informed improvements to operations, clinical quality, and care coordination.
