




This is Bigfoot. Bigfoot is ready for a big day at the local Community Health Center.

Bigfoot doesn't make a big amount of money, but Community Health Centers make sure that important medicine is affordable.




Bigfoot stops at the Therapist's office. She helps Bigfoot manage a big amount of stress.

Community Health Centers first opened in 1965, during the Civil Rights movement. Now they offer affordable health care options for 32.5 million people at 1400 locations nationwide.


